1. Balustrades on balconies serve as decorative railings or protective barriers, enhancing safety while adding aesthetic appeal to outdoor spaces.
2. Pilasters are flat, rectangular columns often attached to a wall's surface for decorative purposes. They mimic the appearance of full columns and add depth and visual interest to a building's façade.
3. Architectural elements contribute to a building's aesthetics by providing visual interest, defining its style, and conveying artistic creativity. For example, decorative windows, ornate doors, and sculpted friezes can enhance the overall beauty of a structure.
4. An example of an architectural element serving both functional and decorative purposes is a stained glass window. It allows natural light to enter a building (functional) while displaying intricate designs and colors (decorative).
5. Friezes in architecture often serve as decorative bands with sculptural reliefs or intricate designs, adding artistic expression and storytelling elements to a building's design.
