How Does a Barracuda Communicate?

Short Answer Key

1. Barracudas communicate with their body by changing posture or making quick, sharp movements.
2. They show their teeth to warn other animals to stay away or to appear more intimidating.
3. Barracudas use their excellent eyesight to observe the movements of their prey and predict where they will go.
4. No, barracudas do not use sounds to communicate because they rely on body language and visual signals instead.
5. When hunting in groups, barracudas rely on visual signals to coordinate their actions.
