How Does a Barracuda Move?

Open-Ended Response Answer Key

1. Speed is important for a barracuda's survival because it allows them to catch prey quickly and escape from predators.
2. Blending in with their surroundings helps barracudas get close to their prey without being noticed, making them more effective hunters.
3. If a barracuda could not move quickly, it might struggle to catch prey or escape from predators, which could threaten its survival.
4. Answers will vary. Students might want to learn more about how their tails generate power or how they navigate tight spaces near coral reefs.
