Badminton Basics: An Introduction to the Sport

Short Answer Key

1. The server is determined by a coin toss.
2. Common faults include "Let" (when the shuttlecock touches the net during a serve), "Out" (when the shuttlecock lands outside the court boundaries), "Foot Fault" (when a player's feet cross the boundary lines during a serve or rally), "Double Hit" (when a player hits the shuttlecock twice in succession), and "Carry" (when a player holds the shuttlecock on their racket or delays hitting it).
3. You need to win two out of three games to win a badminton match.
4. It is considered a fault, and the player loses the point.
5. The net is 5 feet high at the center and 5 feet 1 inch high at the sides of the badminton court.
