Glide and Dart: How Bass Fish Move

1. Bass move by swimming, using their tails and fins.
2. The pectoral fins help bass steer and slow down while swimming.
3. A bass might swim very quickly when escaping a predator or chasing prey.
4. The bass's streamlined body shape helps it cut through the water with little effort.
5. Bass use a technique called stalking, where they move slowly and quietly to sneak up on prey.
