Beach Volleyball vs. Indoor Volleyball: A Sun-Kissed Showdown

Short Answer Key

1. Beach volleyball typically has two players on each side of the net, while indoor volleyball has six.
2. In beach volleyball, teams play to 21 points per set, with a two-point advantage needed to win, and matches are typically best of three sets. In indoor volleyball, teams play to 25 points per set, and matches are typically best of five sets.
3. Beach volleyball players play barefoot because shoes are not suitable for sandy courts, and bare feet provide better traction.
4. Beach volleyball uses a softer, lighter ball, whereas indoor volleyball uses a leather or synthetic leather ball.
5. The court size for beach volleyball is 16 meters in length and 8 meters in width.
