## The Life Cycle of a Bee: From Egg to Adult

### Short Answer Key

1. The four stages of a bee's life cycle are egg, larva, pupa, and adult.
2. It takes about three weeks for a bee to develop from an egg into an adult.
3. Worker bees feed larvae royal jelly and pollen to help them grow.
4. Worker bees live longer in the winter because they are less active and don't wear out as quickly.
5. During the pupa stage, the bee develops wings, legs, eyes, and all the body parts of an adult.
