Short Answer Key

1. Beetles move by running, flying, climbing, or swimming.
2. Water beetles swim using flat, paddle-like legs that help them move smoothly through water.
3. Beetles climb trees to find food or hide from predators.
4. Elytra are hard outer wings that protect the beetle's softer inner wings.
5. Movement helps beetles survive by allowing them to find food, escape predators, and explore their environment.
