Short Answer Key

1. The ostrich can be up to 9 feet tall and weigh up to 220-290 pounds, while the bee hummingbird is only 2 to 2.4 inches in length and weighs about 2.2 grams.
2. One adaptation of the ostrich for survival is its powerful legs, which enable it to run at high speeds to escape predators.
3. The bee hummingbird is found in Cuba and the Isla de la Juventud.
4. The diet of the bee hummingbird primarily consists of nectar from flowers.
5. The small size of the bee hummingbird allows it to navigate through dense foliage and access nectar from tiny flowers with ease.
