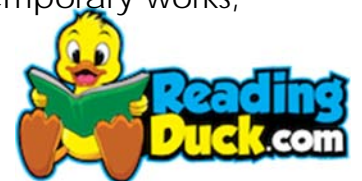
### The Birth of the Club
