What Does a Camel Look Like?

Open-Ended Response Answer Key

1. Camels' humps store fat for energy, wide feet help with walking on sand, long eyelashes and closable nostrils protect from sandstorms, and their fur shields them from temperature extremes.
2. Camels store fat in their humps, which can be used for energy when food is scarce.
3. Dromedary camels have one hump and are mostly found in Africa and the Middle East, while Bactrian camels have two humps and live in Central Asia.
4. Camels can carry supplies, survive long periods without food, and tolerate hot, dry conditions, making them ideal for desert travel.
