Open-Ended Response Answer Key

1. Answers may vary, but students might share their own feelings about participating in such an adventure and whether they would be drawn to the idea of uncovering hidden treasure.
2. Students might explain that the discovery of the letters and keepsakes from past campers could have given the narrator a deeper appreciation for the history and legacy of Camp Sunshine, as well as a sense of belonging to a broader community.
3. Challenges might include overcoming obstacles in the pursuit of adventure, while opportunities could involve forming strong bonds with fellow campers and creating lasting memories.
4. In their view, this story teaches us that shared experiences and friendships are valuable, and they connect us to a larger community. It also emphasizes the importance of preserving and passing down stories and traditions from one generation to the next.
