Famous Landmarks and Tourist Attractions in Canada



Niagara Falls: A Powerful Waterfall

One of the most famous natural wonders in Canada is Niagara Falls. Located on the border between Ontario and the United States, Niagara Falls is made up of three waterfalls: Horseshoe Falls (the largest and most powerful), American Falls, and Bridal Veil Falls. More than 3,000 tons of water flow over the falls every second! Visitors can take a boat ride called "Maid of the Mist" to get up close to the falls and feel the mist on their faces. At night, colorful lights shine on the rushing water, making it a magical sight.

Banff National Park: A Mountain Paradise

Located in the province of Alberta, Banff National Park is one of Canada's most famous parks. It is part of the Rocky Mountains, which are known for their tall, snowy peaks, blue lakes, and wild animals. Visitors can:

- Hike through forests and mountains
- See animals like grizzly bears, elk, and mountain goats
- Enjoy skiing and snowboarding in the winter

One of the most famous spots in Banff is Lake Louise, a lake with bright blue water surrounded by mountains. People love to canoe on the lake in the summer and skate on it in the winter!

The CN Tower: Touching the Sky

- Walk on the glass floor, looking straight down
- Eat at a rotating restaurant that slowly turns while they enjoy their meal
- Try the EdgeWalk, where brave visitors walk outside the tower on a high ledge!

Parliament Hill: Canada's Government Center

In Ottawa, the capital of Canada, there is a beautiful area called Parliament Hill. This is where Canada's government meets to make important decisions. The buildings have a castle-like design, with tall towers and large green rooftops. Some of the best things to see at Parliament Hill include:

- The Peace Tower, which has a giant clock and a bell that rings on special occasions
- Changing of the Guard, a ceremony where soldiers dressed in red uniforms and tall hats march in formation
- Canada Day Celebrations on July 1st, with fireworks, music, and parades
