1. The four seasons in Canada are spring, summer, fall (autumn), and winter.
2. In summer, people go swimming, have barbecues, and play outdoor sports.
3. Leaves change color in the fall because the weather gets cooler, and trees stop making chlorophyll, which gives leaves their green color.
4. People stay warm by wearing heavy coats, scarves, gloves, and boots.
5. In Toronto, summers are hot with temperatures over 30°C, but in the Arctic, it stays cool even in July, and the sun does not set for weeks.
