### Short Answer Key

1. Elizabeth initially finds Lady Catherine de Bourgh to be condescending and domineering in her interactions.
2. Elizabeth refuses Mr. Darcy's proposal in chapter 19 because she is offended by his criticism of her family and social standing and does not love him.
3. Mr. Darcy's letter in chapter 20 influences Elizabeth's perceptions by revealing Mr. Wickham's true character and actions, which contrasts with the negative impression she had of him.
4. Caroline Bingley's jealousy is evident in her attempts to separate Jane and Mr. Bingley by encouraging his interest in Georgiana Darcy and by spreading negative rumors about Jane.
5. Mr. Bingley's return to Netherfield is significant because it rekindles Jane's hopes of a future with him, bringing her closer to a possible marriage.
