3. Discuss the transformation of the boys' appearance and behavior as reflected in their growing dishevelment and the painting of their faces, and what this transformation signifies in terms of their descent into savagery.
4. How does the encounter with the "Lord of the Flies" in Chapter 3 foreshadow the deeper psychological and moral conflicts the boys will face on the island?
