1. Compounds are made of elements that are chemically bonded.
2. Saltwater, air, or soda.
3. Mixture parts are not bonded and can be in any amount; compound parts are always in set amounts.
4. Heat it, mix it with something else, or use special tools like microscopes.
5. Because a mixture can have different amounts of substances, so it may react differently.
