Badminton Court Dimensions and Line Markings: Unveiling the Playing Field

Short Answer Key

1. The baseline serves as the back boundary of the court and is used for serving and defending.
2. The sidelines in a singles match are wider than the sidelines in a doubles match.
3. The short service line is 6 feet, 6 inches away from the net.
4. The "T-area" is formed where the short service line and center service line intersect. It is a critical point for serving in both singles and doubles matches, as it helps players aim for the correct area of the opponent's court.
5. The dimensions of a doubles badminton court are 44 feet in length and 20 feet in width.
