How Does a Crocodile Move?

Open-Ended Response Answer Key

1. It helps them catch prey and escape danger.
2. The tail helps a crocodile swim fast and steer while hunting or escaping danger.
3. Their strong tails help them swim silently, and their bursts of speed on land allow them to catch prey.
4. (Example) If I were a crocodile, I would swim quietly in the water, then use my tail to lunge toward my prey for a quick catch.
