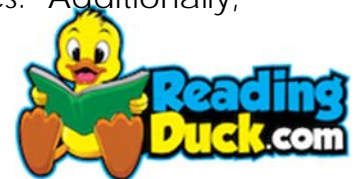
Florida's Education Structure
