Epiphora is the repetition of a certain word or phrase at the end of successive sentences or clauses. The rhythmic repetition emphasizes what is being repeated. The example below is from Abraham Lincoln's Gettysburg Address,

. . . that government  
of the people  
by the people  
for the people  
shall not perish from the Earth.
