Grasshoppers' Homes: Where Do They Live?

Open-Ended Response Answer Key

1. Grasshoppers can live in many habitats because they are adaptable and can eat a variety of plants.
2. A grasshopper's habitat determines what plants are available for it to eat, like grass in fields or leaves in forests.
3. By observing a grasshopper's colors or the plants it's near, you could guess its habitat, like grasslands or forests.
4. Grasshoppers are not found in Antarctica because it is too cold and lacks the plants they need to survive.
