A Day in the Life of a Grasshopper

Short Answer Key

1. Grasshoppers are diurnal, meaning they are active during the day.
2. Grasshoppers rest in shady areas to stay cool during the hottest part of the day.
3. Grasshoppers form swarms to search for food when it is plentiful.
4. Grasshoppers protect themselves by hiding under plants or leaves and staying still at night.
5. Stridulation is the chirping sound grasshoppers make by rubbing their legs against their wings. They do it to attract mates or warn other grasshoppers.
