1. A key feature that distinguishes a duplex from other types of residential buildings is that it consists of two separate units, each with its own entrance, often sharing a common wall.
2. Cooperative housing (co-op) is a form of ownership where residents collectively own and manage the building. Unlike condominiums, where individuals own their units, co-op members hold shares in the cooperative and have the right to occupy a specific unit.
3. The main steps involved in the construction of a residential building include design and planning, foundation construction, framing, walls and roofing, plumbing and electrical installation, interior and exterior finishes, inspections, and occupancy.
4. Insulation in residential buildings serves the purpose of maintaining a comfortable interior temperature by regulating heat flow. It is typically installed in walls, ceilings, and floors.
5. Architects and designers play a crucial role in designing the layout, structural elements, and aesthetics of the building. They also obtain necessary permits, create blueprints, and ensure compliance with building codes.
