Nature's Super-Jumpers - Open-Ended Questions Answer Key

1. Webbed feet help frogs swim well, while sticky toe pads allow them to climb and grip surfaces. These adaptations help frogs survive in both water and on land.
2. If a frog couldn't absorb oxygen through its skin, it might need to come up for air more often, making it harder to stay underwater for long periods.
3. Frogs' ability to see in low light helps them hunt for food and avoid predators at night, when they are most active.
4. Frogs have strong hind legs for jumping, webbed feet for swimming, sticky toes for climbing, and the ability to absorb oxygen and water through their skin. These features help them live in both water and on land.
