1. Ladybugs use tiny claws on their legs to grip surfaces.
2. They lift their elytra and unfold their inner wings.
3. Flying helps ladybugs escape predators, find food, and explore new habitats.
4. Ladybugs cannot swim well but can float and paddle if they fall into water.
5. Ladybugs can climb plant stems and tree trunks.
