1. About 7 to 12 miles above the surface
2. Water vapor is water in gas form; it helps form clouds and rain
3. It forms tiny water droplets that can become clouds
4. The stratosphere is calm and doesn't have storms
5. When warm and cold air mix, it can cause winds and storms
