## Volleyball Court Unveiled: The Dimensions and Layout of the Game

### Short Answer Key

1. The net height in women's volleyball is 2.24 meters (7 feet 4 1/4 inches).
2. The libero is a specialized defensive player who wears a different-colored jersey and is allowed to replace any back-row player without prior notification to the referee. The libero cannot attack or block at the net.
3. One of the zones where back-row players are positioned is the back row (positions 5, 6, and 1).
4. The attack line (3-meter line) is important in volleyball because it regulates player positioning during attacks. Back-row players must stay behind this line when attacking the ball.
5. The antennas on the volleyball net are used to define the court boundaries for legal hits. Any ball that contacts the antenna or passes outside of it is considered out of bounds.
