The Life Cycle of a Panda

Short Answer Key

1. During the first three weeks, a panda cub is pink, hairless, and relies on its mother for warmth and milk.
2. A panda cub starts opening its eyes at around six weeks old.
3. Pandas in captivity live longer because they receive special care, including medical attention and a steady food supply.
4. By one year old, a panda cub weighs around 70 to 100 pounds.
5. Adult pandas spend most of their time eating bamboo, resting, and exploring their territory.
