1. Hatchlings stay safe by climbing trees to avoid predators.
2. Young Komodo dragons eat insects, birds, and small animals.
3. Komodo dragons control prey populations and keep the ecosystem balanced.

5. As they grow larger, young Komodo dragons begin hunting larger prey and spending more time on the ground.
