## Where Does a Monkey Live?

### Open-Ended Response Answer Key

1. Different types of monkeys adapt to their environments by changing their behavior. For example, rainforest monkeys climb trees to find food, while grassland monkeys spend more time on the ground.
2. Protecting monkey habitats is important because it helps monkeys survive and keeps the environment balanced. Without monkeys, some plants might not grow.
3. If rainforests were destroyed, monkeys would lose their homes and have a harder time finding food. This could lead to some species becoming endangered.
