What Does a Rabbit Look Like?

1. A rabbit's ears help it hear predators from far away and stay safe.
2. Wild rabbits are smaller, usually 2 to 4 pounds, while pet rabbits can weigh up to 10 pounds.
3. Rabbits need to chew on things to keep their teeth short because their teeth never stop growing.
4. Two special features of a rabbit's appearance are its long ears and fluffy tail.
5. Lop-eared rabbits have floppy ears that hang down instead of standing up.
