The Incredible Life Cycle of a Moth

Short Answer Key

1. The four stages of a moth's life cycle are egg, larva, pupa, and adult.
2. Moth eggs stay safe because they are laid in protected spots like on the underside of leaves or tree bark.
3. During the larva stage, caterpillars eat plants, leaves, or fruits.
4. Inside the cocoon, the caterpillar transforms into an adult moth by growing wings and changing its body.
5. Some moths stay in the cocoon through the winter to survive cold temperatures.
