1. Birds and bats are two animals that hunt moths.
2. Camouflage helps moths blend in with their surroundings to avoid being seen by predators.
3. Tiny wasps harm moth caterpillars by laying eggs on them, which hatch and feed on the caterpillar.
4. Deforestation removes the plants that moths use for food and shelter, making it harder for them to survive.
5. Moths trick predators by mimicking dangerous insects or showing off bright wing patterns to scare them.
