## How Does a Monkey Move?

### Short Answer Key

1. Arboreal locomotion is moving through trees by climbing, swinging, or leaping.
2. A prehensile tail helps monkeys grab and hold onto branches, giving them extra balance and support.
3. Leaping skills help monkeys travel between trees, avoid danger, and reach food more easily.
4. Monkeys move on the ground by walking on all fours, using both their hands and feet.
5. Most monkeys prefer trees because they provide safety from predators and access to food like fruits and leaves.
