Tragedy in Oklahoma City: The Story of the Oklahoma City Bombing

Short Answer Key

1. The explosion occurred on April 19, 1995, when a rental truck packed with explosives detonated outside the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City.
2. First responders, including firefighters, police officers, and volunteers, played a crucial role in the rescue and recovery efforts by aiding survivors trapped in the rubble and providing assistance to the injured.
3. The second-floor daycare center in the federal building was significant because it housed 19 children who tragically lost their lives in the bombing, adding to the overall toll of victims.
4. The primary individuals responsible for the Oklahoma City Bombing were Timothy McVeigh and Terry Nichols, motivated by their extremist views and hatred for the federal government.
5. The Oklahoma City National Memorial is located in downtown Oklahoma City and features a reflecting pool, 168 empty chairs representing the victims, and a survivor tree. It symbolizes remembrance and healing for those affected by the bombing.
