Open-Ended Answers

1. Fall has cooler temperatures and warm soil, which help plants grow strong roots. There is also more rain in the fall, reducing the need for watering.
2. Perennials do not need to be replanted every year. They just need regular watering, removal of dead leaves or flowers, and occasional dividing.
3. They come back every year, fill in empty spaces, and make the garden look full and lush without the need for frequent replanting.
4. Gardeners can ensure their perennials thrive by planting them in the fall, watering them regularly, removing dead parts, and dividing them every few years
