Open-Ended Response Answer Key

1. Answers will vary based on personal opinions. Students should provide reasons to support their choice of the most effective advocacy strategy employed by NGOs and explain why it is particularly effective.
2. Students should describe specific steps such as participating in international forums, engaging with relevant organizations, presenting data and evidence, and advocating for policy changes on a global scale.
3. Students should research and identify a real-life example of an NGO's successful advocacy campaign, describing the issue, the strategies employed, and the tangible impact of their efforts on policy changes or decision-making.
4. Potential challenges include navigating complex international bureaucracies, competing with other advocacy groups, dealing with resistance from governments, and ensuring that global policies are implemented effectively at the local level.
