### Short Answer Key

1. Repeating the alphabet helps young readers recognize letters and remember their order.
2. Repeated phrases make words familiar, which helps children recognize and recall them more easily.
3. Rhythm makes reading feel like a game or a song, which keeps children engaged and excited.
4. Repetition helps children with letter recognition and builds confidence in reading.
5. The book's repeated words and rhythmic patterns encourage children to chant along and predict what happens next.
