### Short Answer Key

1. Repetition helps children hear and practice numbers in order, making it easier to remember them.
2. Predictability helps children feel comfortable because they can anticipate what comes next, making learning more enjoyable.
3. An example is "one by one, the little one stops to suck his thumb." Rhyming helps children recognize word patterns and develop reading skills.
4. When children can remember the words and sing along, they feel successful, which makes learning fun and engaging.
5. Songs with repeating patterns make it easy to add clapping, marching, or other actions, helping children stay engaged and active.
