Scoring in Badminton: Unraveling the Points System

Short Answer Key

1. Scoring in badminton allows players to score points regardless of who serves.
2. The minimum number of points needed to win a game in badminton is 21.
3. Rally scoring in badminton awards a point to the player or team that wins each rally, regardless of who serves.
4. In a competitive badminton match, typically, the best of three games are played.
5. When the score in a badminton game is tied at 20-20, the game continues until one player or team leads by at least two points.
