1. Stick insects are active at night to avoid predators that are more active during the day.
2. Moving slowly helps stick insects avoid drawing attention from predators.
3. Stick insects live alone to stay hidden and avoid attracting predators.
4. Stick insects sway back and forth to mimic the movement of a twig in the wind.
5. During the breeding season, male stick insects search for females, and females lay eggs after mating.
