### Short Answer Key

1. Britain passed the Stamp Act to raise money, but colonists protested because they had no representation in Parliament.
2. The Townshend Acts taxed goods like glass, paper, and tea. Colonists responded by boycotting British goods.
3. The Boston Tea Party happened because the Tea Act still taxed tea, and colonists wanted to protest British control.
4. The Intolerable Acts punished the colonies by closing Boston's harbor and taking away self-government.
5. The Navigation Acts forced colonists to trade only with Britain, which hurt their economy and made them feel controlled.
