- **Hitter:** Hitters, also known as spikers or attackers, are responsible for hitting the ball over the net to score points.

### Hits and Plays

- **Spike:** A powerful hit where a player jumps and smashes the ball over the net into the opponent's court.
- **Block:** When players jump and raise their hands to prevent the ball from crossing the net, it's called a block. This is a defensive move to stop the opponent's attack.
- **Dig:** A dig is a defensive move where a player dives to save a ball from hitting the ground. It keeps the ball in play.

### Gameplay

- **Rotation:** Players rotate positions clockwise after their team wins a rally and earns the serve.
- **Rally:** A rally is the sequence of plays between the serve and the point being scored. It involves passing, setting, and hitting the ball over the net.
- **Side-Out:** When the receiving team wins the rally, they earn the right to serve, and this is called a side-out.

### Basic Rules

- **Double Hit:** A player can't hit the ball twice in a row, except when blocking.
- **Foot Fault:** When a player steps on or over the baseline while serving, it's called a foot fault, and the serve is lost.
- **Net Violation:** Touching the net with any part of the body during play is a violation.
