1. Some readers may think the narrator is too arrogant to realize the irony, while others might believe he understands it too late.
2. The irony makes the reader anxious because they know something bad is coming, even if the narrator does not.
3. "I would have tried to make up for what I did instead of letting my guilt turn into fear and anger."
4. Many horror stories use irony, like in The Tell-Tale Heart, where the narrator also thinks he has hidden his crime but ends up revealing it.
