1. The president can sign the bill, ignore it, or veto it.
2. Congress must get a two-thirds majority vote in both houses, which is very hard to do.

4. He used vetoes to stop laws that could have hurt his New Deal programs.
5. The veto helps keep balance in the government by making sure the president and Congress both have power.
