How Does a Walking Leaf Move?

Short Answer Key

1. Walking leaves use their legs for walking, climbing, and gripping branches.
2. Walking leaves move slowly to mimic the natural motion of leaves and avoid detection by predators.
3. Their slow and gentle movements sway like a leaf in the wind, blending them into their environment.
4. Some walking leaves fly short distances to escape predators or move between nearby plants.
5. Their climbing ability helps them stay close to the leaves they eat.
