How Does a Walking Leaf Move?

Open-Ended Response Answer Key

1. The walking leaf's slow movement helps it blend into its surroundings, making it harder for predators to spot them.
2. If walking leaves moved too quickly, they would break their disguise, making it easier for predators to notice them.
3. Walking leaves are designed to climb efficiently because it helps them stay safe in trees and close to their food sources.
4. The ability to fly short distances allows walking leaves to escape danger quickly while still maintaining their leaf-like disguise.
