## Whales and Their Relationships with Other Species

### Short Answer Key

1. Whales push schools of fish to the surface while feeding, making it easier for seabirds to catch fish.
2. Barnacles attach to whales to travel through nutrient-rich waters, where they can filter-feed.
3. Whale lice can cause irritation and wounds by feeding on the whale's skin.
4. Whales bring nutrients from the ocean depths to the surface, which helps plankton thrive.
