Rolling Through Life: The Marvels of the Wheel and Axle

Open-Ended Response Answer Key

1. An example of a unique use of a wheel and axle is a record player. The wheel represents the record, and the axle is the spindle on which the record rotates. The needle reads the grooves on the record, producing sound.
2. In a world without wheels and axles, transportation would be significantly limited. Cars, bicycles, and most forms of modern transportation would not exist. Heavy objects would be harder to move, and tasks that rely on rotation would be more challenging.
3. Wheels and axles and levers both provide mechanical advantages, but they operate differently. Levers involve a fulcrum and two lever arms, while wheels and axles have a wheel that rotates around an axle. Levers are often used for lifting or moving in a straight line, while wheels and axles are used for circular motion and mobility.
